Junior Delegate Process:

To be considered as a candidate for Junior Delegate, you must meet the following requirements at the time of 2022 National Assembly:

- You must attend the 2022 National Assembly.
- You must be between 18 and 25 years of age. (Those who turn 18 at least ten days before National Assembly 7/1-7/7/22 will be considered as well)
- You must be currently active in GFS, a member of good standing, and have at least 3 years of GFS experience.
- You will give a presentation at National Assembly during a business meeting.
- You will meet with the Junior Delegate selection committee for a brief interview.

Any member who meets these requirements can apply. Our hope is that many girls will compete for this high honor and all who participate will benefit from its process.

The GFS/USA Junior Delegate is a voting member of the GFS USA National Board as well as the National Youth Delegate at World Council, and has the following duties and responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in all GFS/USA Board meetings
- Work with the Director and Assistant Directors of Ambassadors
- Attend World Council and participate in all activities
- Make written reports to the GFS/USA Board at all meetings and following World Council

If you are chosen as the Alternate Junior Delegate, you have the following obligations:

- Be a GFS/USA representative at the General Convention/ Triennial Convention of the Episcopal Church in 2024
- Assume the duties of the Junior Delegate should she be unable to fulfill her duties



The GFS/USA selection process consists of a <u>written application</u> and an <u>individual interview</u> as well as a <u>presentation</u> during National Assembly 2022.

Please review the enclosed application. If you decide to apply, please complete the application immediately. You must complete all of the paperwork that is enclosed.

To be considered, your completed paperwork <u>MUST</u> be postmarked or emailed by July 1, 2022.

All applications received will be reviewed for consideration for the Junior Delegate. **Any incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

 - 2. Your Priest
 - 3. A Non-related adult (teacher, employer, neighbor, parishioner, etc.)
- A letter to the GFS/USA Jr. Delegate Selection Committee explaining your interest in representing your peers on the GFS USA National Board and in representing GFS USA at World Council in South Africa in the summer of 2023.

Please prepare a two (2) minute presentation with visuals (can be a PowerPoint or poster, etc.). Applicants may choose any topic of their choice.
